Nga: To be implemented from next year; Those who default on PTPTN are prohibited from leaving the country

PENANG, Jan 6 -- The National Higher Education Fund Authority (PTPTN) has defaulted on loans amounting to RM9 billion so far, and the government will ban those who owe money from leaving the country next year, and once implemented, the passports of those who owe money will not be available, said Minister of Housing and Local Government Ngai Ko Min.

He said this when he spoke to young people at a citizens' meeting on World Habitat Day on Sunday.

He said there were a lot of PTPTN borrowers who had not repaid their loans, which was extremely irresponsible.

"It's a shame that you took money from the government, went to college, and then didn't want to repay the loan.

He denounced this behavior as robbing future young people of access to loans, because the money is used for educational purposes.

"Defaulting on a loan is a bad behavior, and if you can't change your behavior, you don't have to talk about changing the country's mind, it all starts with repaying the PTPTN loan.

Ke Min (right) has a casual dialogue with the public, especially young people, at Ta Tung Tsai Park Penang may host a Malaysia Cleanup next year. Next year, the state may be expected to be the "Clean Malaysia Day" to clean up the beaches of Penang! Housing and Local Government Minister Ngai Kha Min revealed during a town hall meeting on World Habitat Day on Sunday that the ministry had discussed with the Penang state authorities about next year's Hari Cuci Malaysia campaign, which would clean up all beaches in Penang.

But? When questioned at a press conference, he clarified that the ministry has not yet decided on a location for the event, and further study is still needed, but the Penang state authorities have expressed their intention to host the event.

"With the Penang government's outstanding track record, including a number of international awards, Penang is certainly one of the strongest contenders to host this event, and we will liaise closely with the Penang government to decide which state to host the event.

It doesn't matter who does it, the most important thing is the national participation, which is a national campaign, and not only government agencies and non-governmental organizations, but next year the ministry will also invite school students to participate, in order to cultivate in students from an early age that everyone is responsible for caring for the environment.

"Next year's Clean Malaysia Day has been finalised for 27 September with a target of 100,000 participants.

Ni Kemin also mentioned that this year's first Clean Malaysia Day successfully broke 3 Malaysia Records? This includes the maximum number of participants (58,000 people), the maximum amount of garbage collected (4,650 tonnes) and the longest cleaning campaign (12 hours of non-stop).

Praise Penang Ipoh for winning UN-Habitat award Ni Kemin praised Penang and Ipoh for winning UN-Habitat awards for bringing glory to Malaysia.

Last year, Penang won the UN-Habitat Global Urban Sustainable Development Award (Shanghai Award), and Ipoh won the UN-Habitat Honorary Award this year, which means that Malaysia has won the UN-Habitat Award for the second consecutive year, demonstrating Malaysia's outstanding achievements in green development and sustainable management.

He hoped that the 156 local governments across the country would follow suit with Penang and Ipoh and further improve their urban management standards and win more international accolades for our country.

He also said? Sustainable development is an important agenda for local government development, and he believes that "lighting up" and clean toilets are not only the government's aspirations, but also the people's goal to jointly build Malaysia into the cleanest and most beautiful country in Southeast Asia.
